Quadri di Manovra per Ascensori
Lifts Control Panels

Under the Dodd Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, Section 1502, passed by the US Congress in July 2010, the United States aim to regulate the use of minerals coming from countries affected by conflicts or extensive human rights violations, such as the Democratic Republic of Congo and neighboring countries.

With this legislation, the United States have the objective of discouraging companies and their suppliers from continuing to use minerals from the aforementioned area in their production processes to avoid fueling regional conflicts.

This legislation does not prohibit the use of non conflict-free minerals, but it obliges companies that make use of minerals from the area in question to declare their origin. As a consequence, companies are obliged to trace the origin of some minerals including Tin, Tungsten, Tantalum and Gold.

Following the same principles, the European Union in May 2017 published Regulation (EU) 2017/821 laying down supply chain due diligence obligations for Union importers of Tin, Tantalum and Tungsten, their ores, and Gold (3TG minerals and metals) originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

PELAZZA PEPPINO Srl is a company that designs and produces control panels and components for lifts: it does not purchase metals directly from mines, foundries or refineries, but only products, components and/or semi-finished products that could potentially contain minerals coming from regions of conflict.

However, in compliance with the provisions in the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, Section 1502, and with the Regulation (EU) 2017/821, **PELAZZA PEPPINO Srl**, although not in a position to be able to certify the country of origin of the minerals contained in the products it purchases, is committed to raise awareness among its suppliers, to collect useful information to trace the supply chain of these minerals and to share this information with its Customers and relevant authorities.
